English 2: Introduction to the Novel

Focus on Jane Austen's *Pride and Prejudice*, Charles Dickens' *Great Expectations*, and Virginia Woolf's *Mrs. Dalloway*.

English 4ABC: Creative Writing

Focus on travel writing, in all genres.

Both classes meet Monday-Thursday.

Two pre-trip class meetings TBA.

Program fee includes:

- Homestay accommodation in Oxford; hotel accommodation in London.
- Group airport transfer upon arrival, and transfer from Oxford to London.
- Orientation in Oxford, including half-day walking tour, entrance to Christ Church College, and welcome dinner; Hop On Hop Off sightseeing tour of London.
- Overnight tour to Jane Austen sites including her home in Chawton, her grave in Winchester, the village of Lacock, one of the settings for the 1995 film of *Pride and Prejudice*; Vyne House, where Austen attended dances. B & B accommodation in Bath; walking tour there with visits to the Cathedral, Roman Baths, Fashion Museum, and Number 1 Royal Crescent, and afternoon tea.
- Overnight tour through Cotswold villages to Stratford-upon-Avon. Evening performance of Royal Shakespeare Company. Walking tour of Stratford and Shakespeare sites.
- Excursion to Blenheim Palace; punting excursion in Oxford.
- Excursion focusing on Virginia Woolf includes private bus, entrances to Charleston, and visits to Sissinghurst, Berwick Church, and Woolf's home, Monk's House.
- Excursion to Rochester, the setting for *Great Expectations*, plus sites associated with Dickens.
- Travel passes in Oxford and London; National Trust membership, ticket to West End theatre performance.
- Excursion to Kew Gardens by riverboat (return by Tube).
- Guided tours to Dickens' House Museum, and walking tour of Dickens' London.
- Guided tour of Woolf's Bloomsbury, plus walking tour that follows the path of *Mrs. Dalloway*.
- Plus guided visits to other sites, museums, and adventures in Oxford and London.
- Student medical and liability coverage, AIFS staff in London. Group airfare and optional excursions also available.
