

ARRIVALS: LUGGAGE



Once you have cleared immigration, (enter as a tourist) collect your luggage from the carousel

Missing bags?

File a claim with the customer service desk BEFORE exiting the baggage area

Give the AIFS office address and duty cell phone number, as on your luggage tags

Lost/delayed bags usually arrive within 24/48 hours- pack a change of clothes & essentials in your carry-on just in case

Expensive hairdryer / flat irons

Bring adaptors

No need for a convertor

Any doubts- ask!

INTERNET & WIFI ACCESS



Free Wifi in accommodation and study center

Expect it to be slower, less available

World average download speeds

CA (58 Mbps) vs Spain (16 Mbps)

Remember the time difference (9 hours)

Respect your roommates

Plenty to see in the city...

Be careful what you post on social media!

KEEPING IN TOUCH



Download apps to your smartphone: Whatsapp, Skype

Consider an international plan

OR Turn off data & roaming to avoid a huge bill

Consider purchasing a cheap local cellphone or a sim card for an unlocked cellphone

Mail postcards and letters to family and friends at home

YOUR U.S. SMARTPHONE



Check insurance

Use as wifi device

Roaming data - caution

Take care if using as a map

Do not place on table of cafes/restaurants

Use common sense

RECEIVING MAIL



Care packages- send with caution!

Mark all packages "used personal goods"

Beware importation taxes for U.S. goods

Expect packages to take at least a week if sent with USPS


