IMPORTANT: If you will be applying for financial aid, please read #3 before enrolling with AIFS

First, ENROLL WITH AIFS by clicking on the following link:

- a. From the above link, go to where it says "Click here to complete your enrollment form." (Make sure you use the same name as your passport and answer the questions honestly. Also, medications need to be listed in case of an emergency).
- b. Complete the enrollment form and make your deposit on the AIFS website. You will need to make the \$450 deposit before we will give you Priority Registration).
- c. Once you have completed the AIFS Enrollment Form *and* have made your deposit on the AIFS website, you will be contacted by Patty Warne of the Study Abroad Office to set up an appointment for you to come in and review your paperwork. In the meantime, if you have questions, you may contact her at pwarne@santarosa.edu or (707) 527-4441, or you may contact Terri Frongia, your Barcelona instructor for Fall 2017 at tfrongia@santarosa.edu or call her at (707) 778-3968. You are encouraged to attend one of Prof. Frongia's informational meetings that will mostly take place during the spring 2017 semester. Check the Barcelona 2017 website under the Information link (<https://study-abroad.santarosa.edu/barcelona-fall-2017-information>) for meeting dates and times; we'll also post them on the Study Abroad office window, Rm. 1525.
- d. Once you have an appointment, bring all of the following to the Study Abroad Office at Santa Rosa Junior College, Modern and Classical Languages Lab/Emeritus Hall, Room 1525 at the earliest possible time in order to qualify for Priority Registration. Eventually you'll apply online to each of the four colleges in the consortium you take a class through--Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC), Skyline College, Sacramento City College (SCC), and Diablo Valley College (DVC)--but not until **after** these colleges contact you for registration. But when you do apply, make sure you indicate that you are a California resident (if you are) so you are not charged "out of state" fees while you are abroad. Also, keep your Student ID number from each college for reference.

 - ☐ Photocopy of your passport information page (the page with your picture). Note: If you do not have a passport, **apply for one now. DO NOT WAIT!** Bring us a copy when you get it or bring it in and we will make a copy. **Make sure your passport is valid for 6 months after your Fall 2017 semester ends (valid through June 8, 2018).**
 - ☐ Bring in two 2" x 2" passport photos.
2. Bring in the Course Preference Sheet (under "Barcelona Fall 2017 Classes": <https://study-abroad.santarosa.edu/barcelona-fall-2017-classes>), and the signed Liability Waiver and Consortium Agreement (these can be found at the bottom of the Application Information webpage, at <https://study-abroad.santarosa.edu/barcelona-fall-2015-application-process>).
