



The AIFS program fee of \$3,495.00 includes the following (based on an enrollment of 20 or more participants):

- ⇒ accommodation in multi-bedded rooms on a self-catering basis in a student lodge in Cape Town with shared bathrooms, kitchen and living areas and access to WiFi;
- ⇒ group public transportation to and from all scheduled visits;
- ⇒ orientation program on-site in Cape Town consisting of an orientation meeting with AIFS staff, information packet, guided half-day sightseeing tour of Cape Town by private bus and multi-course African welcome meal with entertainment and interactive African drumming session;
- ⇒ tour and talk at the District Six Museum including Coffee and Koe'sister;
- ⇒ entrance to the Jewish Museum and guided tour of St. George's Cathedral;
- ⇒ half-day excursion to Cape Point including a visit to Boulder's Beach penguin colony;
- ⇒ half-day excursion to Lynedoch Eco Village and a tasting at a local Stellenbosch Winery;
- ⇒ full-day excursion to Table Mountain including tickets for the Aerial Cableway and entrance to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens;
- ⇒ four-day, three-night guided excursion along the Garden Route with shared accommodations in backpacker dorms, a "Big Five" game drive at a private game reserve, an elephant bush walk, canoeing on the Wilderness lagoon and visits to Pinnacle Point Caves, among others;
- ⇒ four-day, three-night excursion to the Kalahari including round-trip flights from Cape Town to Upington, round-trip airport transfers, accommodation in chalets, three meals daily, and a guided minivan tour through Au-grabies Falls National Park and Riemvasmaak Community Conservatory;
- ⇒ extended day trip to Franschhoek including tickets to Franschhoek Bastille Festival, Mont Rochelle Nature Reserve and a three-course group meal at Haute Cabriere;
- ⇒ the services of an AIFS staff member to assist the group and provide 24-hour emergency contact service;
- ⇒ medical and program fee refund insurance policies.

Program fee does not include the following:

- ⇒ optional Transportation Package including round-trip airfare between San Francisco and Cape Town, and round-trip transfers between the airport overseas and your program site on the specified program dates for \$1,195;
- ⇒ mandatory additional U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$506 (subject to change);
- ⇒ \$125 refundable damage deposit;
- ⇒ tuition fees to your college;
- ⇒ textbooks;
- ⇒ meals not listed above;
- ⇒ passport and visa fees if applicable;
- ⇒ additional field trips or excursions required by your instructors;
- ⇒ personal expenses such as laundry;
- ⇒ optional personal effects coverage and medical insurance upgrade.

All students must submit the \$450 deposit when completing the online enrollment form. Subsequent payments may be made by check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to "AIFS." American Express, MasterCard and Visa are accepted.

Please note: AIFS will charge a \$35 returned check fee on all checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

AIFS TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE

Participants have the option of purchasing a round-trip ticket for the flight arranged through AIFS. Participants choosing this option should note the following restrictions: Tickets purchased from AIFS are exclusively on scheduled airlines (not charters). They are not endorsable to another carrier. Flights are not necessarily direct or non-stop, they cannot be rerouted, and frequent flyer miles are not applicable. The AIFS Transportation Package includes round-trip ground transportation from the airport in Cape Town to your accommodations on the regularly scheduled program dates. AIFS will book flights only on the dates indicated on this application.

Participants wishing to purchase the Transportation Package must notify AIFS in writing by Friday, March 10, 2017, or by selecting this option on the online enrollment form. Participants wishing to cancel from the flight must notify AIFS in writing by Wednesday, April 19, 2017. Cancellation penalties will apply. Tickets are non-refundable after this date.

AIFS Airfare Regulations: Return must be to original U.S. departure city. Tickets are subject to airline availability. No refunds are available for any unused portion of ticket. Stopovers are not permitted. Once in Cape Town participants may be able to change their return date, but only if that date is available and in the same class of service in which the ticket was booked. Only the ticketing agent can provide this information. Participants are subject to agency and airline-imposed change fees and space availability. Group round-trip ground transportation to and from the airport in Cape Town is on the regularly scheduled program dates only.

AIFS cannot guarantee that all passengers will be booked on the same flight.

AIFS will not make your flight arrangements for you unless you clearly indicate your travel preferences on your online enrollment form.

A minimum of 12 participants must take the flight for it to be offered.
