1. Complete the enrollment form and make your deposit on the AIFS website. You will need to make the \$450 deposit before we will enroll you in the program.
 - a. Once you have completed the AIFS Enrollment Form on the AIFS website, you will be contacted by Patty Warne of the Study Abroad Office to set up an appointment for you to come in and review your paperwork. - Copy of this Students Steps to Enrollment Form.
- Photocopy of your passport information page (the page with your picture). Note: If you do not have a passport, **apply for one now. DO NOT WAIT!** Bring us a copy when you get it or bring it in and we will make a copy. **Make sure your passport is valid for 6 months after your summer 2017 semester ends on July 17, 2017 (should be valid through Jan. 17, 2018).**
- Bring in two 2"x2" passport photos.
- Bring in the signed Liability Waiver and Agreement forms (these can be found at the bottom of the Application Information webpage).

2. Financial Aid: **PLEASE NOTE: There is very little available in financial aid for summer programs. You can get the BOG fee waiver based on your FAFSA. There are no student loans in the Summer semester.**
