PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Academic program organized by the NCSAC Community Colleges and taught by U.S. instructors; 12–15 units of transferable college credit awarded by the participating colleges (tuition fees are extra and will be paid directly to your home school.) All classes are transferable to CSU and/or UC systems and meet GE requirements.
- Financial Aid available to eligible students.
- Courses relevant to Italy and Europe.
- Housing in twin-bedded rooms in apartments located in the Historical Center of Florence.
- Low-cost cultural program including such events as walking tours, cooking classes, ballet, soccer matches and wine lectures. Also included are day trips outside of Florence, concerts and film nights.
- Guided day trip to Siena and San Gimignano.
- Study center in the Historic Center of Florence with free wireless Internet access.
- Italian Life and Culture course.
- Support services, medical insurance, travel arrangements and student advisors provided by AIFS.
- Optional Transportation Package including round-trip flights between SFO and Florence and airport transfers in Florence.
