- a. From the above link, go to where it says "Click here to complete your enrollment form." (Make sure you use the same name as your passport and answer the questions honestly.)
- b. Complete the enrollment form and make your deposit on the AIFS website. <u>You</u> will need to make the \$450 deposit before we will give you Priority Registration).
- c. Once you have completed the AIFS Enrollment Form and have made your deposit on the AIFS website, you will be contacted by Patty Warne of the Study Abroad Office to set up an appointment for you to come in and review your paperwork. You are encouraged to attend one of Prof. Mulcaire's informational meetings that will take place sometime after the Fall 2017 semester begins. d. Once you have an appointment, bring all of the following to the Study Abroad Office at Santa Rosa Junior College, World Languages Lab/Emeritus Hall, Room 1525 at the earliest possible time in order to qualify for Priority Registration. Eventually you'll apply online to each of the four colleges in the consortium that you're taking a class though--Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC), Skyline College (SKY), American River College (ARC), and Diablo Valley College (DVC)--but not until after these colleges contact you for registration. But when you do apply, make sure you indicate that you are a California resident (if you are) so you are not charged "out of state" fees while you are abroad. Also, keep your Student ID number from each college for reference.

Note: If you do not have a passport, **apply for one now**. **DO NOT WAIT!** Bring us a copy when you get it or bring it in and we will make a copy. **Make sure your passport** is valid for 6 months after your Spring 2018 semester ends (valid through October 27, 2018).
