AIFS PROGRAM FEES AND WHAT IS AND IS NOT INCLUDED

(Note that the AIFS price below does not include airfare and SRJC tuition fees.)

The AIFS program fee of **\$5,295** includes the following (based on an enrollment of 20 participants):

--group transportation and transfers to and from all scheduled visits (ferry, bus, train);

--in Syracuse, accommodation in self-catered apartments with kitchen and shared twin-bedded bedrooms in a central location in Syracuse; in Agrigento, Lipari and Naples, accommodation in multi-bedded rooms in a centrally-located tourist class hotel with daily breakfast;

--access to Wi-Fi at student facilities and accommodations;

--a welcome meal and a farewell dinner;

--orientation program in Syracuse and half-day walking tour of Ortygia with the services of a professional, English-speaking guide;

--in Naples, a travel pass for unlimited use of the bus, metro and funicular in the central area for the duration of the section;

--the services of an AIFS staff member to assist the group and provide 24-hour emergency contact service;

--medical and program fee refund insurance policies;

-- cultural activities and excursions as listed below:

In Syracuse:

- A joint entrance ticket to the Neapolis Archaeological Park and Paolo Orsi Museum.
- A full day excursion by private transportation to the Necropolis of Pantalica and Thapsos with the services of a professional, English-speaking guide.
- A full day excursion to Mt. Etna, including a visit to the INGV Center, volcanological museum and monitoring rooms and a guided hike to the Crateri Silverstri.
- A two-day, one-night excursion to the Agrigento region, including private transportation and accommodation. Also included are site visits to Scala di Turchi, Valley of the Temples archaeological site and museum, and Villa Romana Casale.
- A visit en-route to Lipari to Alcantara Gorges with river trekking.

In Lipari:

• A guided walk up Monte Pilato with private transportation and the services of a professional, English-speaking guide.

- Entrance to the Eolian Museum.
- A full day excursion to Vulcano by motorboat as part of a public tour, inclusive of a professional, English-speaking guide.
- A full day excursion to the prehistoric village of Panarea and Stromboli by motorboat as part of a public tour, inclusive of a professional, English-speaking guide.

In Naples:

- A visit to Pompeii Archaeological Site including entrance and public transportation.
- A visit to Herculaneum Archaeological Site and Mt. Vesuvius including entrance and private transportation.
- A full day excursion by private transportation to Campi Flegrei Archaeological Museum and Cuma excavations.
- Entrance to the Naples Archaeological Museum.
- A faculty led visit to the Fontanelle cemetery.

(Should any of the above visits be unavailable they will be replaced with a suitable alternative, in liaison with the College faculty.)

The AIFS program fee does **not** include the following:

--optional Transportation Package for approximately \$2,035 that includes: round-trip airfare SFO to Catania (CTA), returning Naples (NAP) to SFO; round-trip transfers overseas between the airport and the housing in Syracuse; and all U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees, and fuel surcharges (subject to change);

--refundable damage deposit (still need to confirm but probably \$125);

- --tuition fees to Santa Rosa Junior College
- --textbooks;
- --meals not listed above;
- --passport and visa fees if applicable;
- --additional field trips or excursions not listed as part of program;
- --personal expenses such as laundry;
- --optional personal effects coverage and medical insurance upgrade.
