#### AIFS NARRATIVE QUESTIONS

Please type each narrative and send them either as a Word document or PDF. The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee doesn't have length requirements but they suggest around a half-page or so (more is fine) for Narrative #1, and however long it takes for you to put down some blog ideas for Narrative #2.

Narrative #1: Why do you want to study abroad in Barcelona?

Narrative #2: Submit a proposal of how you will work with AIFS and the SRJC Study Abroad Office to promote the Study Abroad Program (this means your willingness to maintain a blog during your trip).

Your proposal should include:

- --Agreeing to work with the AIFS coordinator (who may give you some weekly suggestions on themes) and to keep your blog updated for a reasonable time throughout the program;
- --Providing personal insights and observations through, for example, blog entries, photos, video footage, or any other support materials that you would want to use to promote the program;
- --Mentioning that you'll provide your blog address to the SRJC Study Abroad office so that it can be posted on the SRJC Study Abroad website.
