#### AIFS NARRATIVE QUESTIONS

Please type each narrative and send them either as a Word document or PDF. The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee doesn't have length requirements but they suggest around a half-page or so (more is fine) for Narrative #1, and however long it takes for you to put down some blog/vlog ideas for Narrative #2.

Narrative #1: Why do you want to study abroad in Florence?

Narrative #2: Submit a proposal of how you will work with AIFS and the SRJC Study Abroad Office to promote the Study Abroad Program (this means your willingness to maintain a blog/vlog during your trip).

Your proposal should include:

- --Agreeing to keep your blog/vlog updated for a reasonable time (at least once every two weeks) throughout the program.
- --Providing personal insights and observations through, for example, blog/vlog entries, photos, video footage, or any other support materials. Give us some of your ideas of what you anticipate some of your themes will be, as well as what your planned platform will be.
- --Mentioning that you'll provide your blog/vlog address to the SRJC Study Abroad office so that it can be posted on the SRJC Study Abroad website. (We will also provide your address to AIFS for their use.)

Note: Some of you may have heard from other participants of our past programs about "challenge" assignments from AIFS, which require you to take pictures and provide videos of certain themes that are given to you on a regular basis by AIFS. However, this blog/vlog will be in lieu of these challenge assignments and you'll be expected to come up with your own ideas for content.
