Narrative #1: Why do you want to study abroad in Ireland?

**Narrative #2:** Submit a proposal of how you will work with AIFS and the SRJC Study Abroad Office to promote the Study Abroad Program (this means your willingness to maintain a blog during your trip).

Your proposal should include:

--Agreeing to work with the AIFS coordinator (who may give you some weekly suggestions on themes) and to keep your blog updated for a reasonable time throughout the program;

--Providing personal insights and observations through, for example, blog entries, photos, video footage, or any other support materials that you would want to use to promote the program;

--Mentioning that you'll provide your blog address to the SRJC Study Abroad office so that it can be posted on the SRJC Study Abroad website.
