AIFS NARRATIVE QUESTIONS

Please type each narrative and send them either as a Word document or PDF. The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee doesn't have length requirements but they suggest around a half-page or so (more is fine) for Narrative #1, and however long it takes for you to put down some blog/vlog ideas for Narrative #2.

Narrative #1: Why do you want to study abroad in Japan?

Narrative #2: Submit a proposal of how you will work with the SRJC Study Abroad Office and AIFS to promote the Study Abroad Program (this means your willingness to maintain a blog or vlog during your trip).

Your proposal should include:

- Agreeing to keep your blog updated for a reasonable time throughout the program (posting at least once a week).

- Providing personal insights and observations through, for example, blog or vlog entries, photos, video footage, or any other support materials that you would want to use to promote the program. Give us some of your ideas of what you anticipate some of your themes will be, as well as what your planned platform will be.

- Mentioning that you'll provide your blog address to the SRJC Study Abroad office so that it can be posted on the SRJC Study Abroad website.
