

Study Abroad Financial Aid Process

Florence Spring 2027

- Keep your FAFSA up to date. Fill out 2027/2028 FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov once it's available in early October 2026.
- If you are eligible for the CA Promise Grant (which waives your tuition fees), add these school codes to your FAFSA: 001287 (for SRJC, which you probably already have), 001191 (for Diablo Valley College), 006973 (for Cañada College), and 001232 (for American River College). Putting these codes in will allow these schools to process your CA Promise Grant if you take a class through them.
- Check out the Gilman Scholarship at: <https://www.gilmanscholarship.org/>
To be eligible for the Gilman, you must be eligible for the Pell Grant. The Gilman deadline is Oct. 1, 2026. On the application, put Kerry Loewen as your Study Abroad advisor and Lauren Coburn as your Financial Aid advisor.
- If you have any questions about financial aid in relation to your Florence Study Abroad experience, please call the SRJC Financial Aid Office at (707) 527-4471 and **ask to schedule an appointment to discuss Study Abroad**. (You can also go to the Financial Aid Office in Plover on the Santa Rosa campus to schedule an appointment.) By scheduling an appointment to discuss Study Abroad, you'll be connected with staff who can best address your costs, potential resources, forms, as well as answer your financial aid questions.
- The SRJC Financial Aid office will have forms ("Consortium Agreement Forms") for you to fill out later in the fall 2026 semester. The Study Abroad Office will supply the Financial Aid Office with the names of the participants of the program and then Financial Aid staff will contact you regarding the forms.
- Be sure to also check out the SRJC scholarship opportunities on AwardSpring. The application window for the spring 2027 AwardSpring scholarships begins approximately the second week of the fall 2026 semester.
- **When the SRJC Financial Aid Office asks you for paperwork, you must fill it out and get it back to them to receive your financial aid.**
