

# Study Abroad Financial Aid Process

## London Fall 2026

- Fill out 2026/2027 FAFSA at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) (if you haven't already). The priority deadline is March 2, 2026. (You can still fill it out after the priority deadline, but it could affect the amount you receive.)
- If you are eligible for the CA Promise Grant (which waives your tuition fees), add these school codes to your FAFSA: 001287 (for SRJC, which you probably already have), 001191 (for Diablo Valley College), 006973 (for Cañada College), and 001232 (for American River College). Putting these codes in will allow these schools to process your CA Promise Grant if you take a class through them.
- Check out the Gilman Scholarship at: <https://www.gilmanscholarship.org/> If you are eligible for the Gilman (that is, you receive or are eligible for the Pell Grant), the application will open in mid-January and the due date will be March 5, 2026. On the application, put Kerry Loewen as your Study Abroad advisor and Lauren Coburn as your Financial Aid advisor.

- The SRJC Financial Aid office will have forms ("Consortium Agreement Forms") for you to fill out later in the spring 2026 semester—usually in May or June. We'll supply the Financial Aid office with the names of the participants of the program and then they'll contact you regarding the forms. If you have any concerns about the forms, email Alejandrina or Lauren.
- Be sure to also check out the SRJC scholarship opportunities on AwardSpring. The application window for fall 2026 AwardSpring scholarships begins approximately the second week of the spring 2026 semester.
- **When the SRJC Financial Aid office asks you for paperwork, you must fill it out and get it back to them to receive your financial aid.**
