PROGRAM INCLUDES

Academic program offered through the NCSAC community colleges. All classes are transfer-level and/or meet GE/IGETC requirements.

Financial aid available to eligible students.

Classes focus on global competence and general education, and are site-enhanced. The Spanish Life and Culture course is included (Community college tuition fees apply.)

Housing in double rooms in local homestays including daily breakfast and dinner, in central Barcelona. A student apartment option is available for a supplemental fee.

Travel pass for use on buses and the metro in the central zone.

Study Center with free wireless Internet access.

Subsidized cultural program including events such as cooking classes, sporting events, walking tours, theater and dance performances, tapas evenings and day trips.

Articket pass providing one free entry to each of six Art museums in Barcelona.

Support services, medical insurance, travel arrangements and student advisors provided by AIFS.

Optional Transportation Package (SFO-Barcelona-SFO) including round-trip airport transfers in Barcelona.
