Provisional Student Advisory for SRJC's Study Abroad Program: Florence Spring 2021

Students signing up for SRJC's Spring 2021 Semester in Florence must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have completed 12 transferable college units with a grade point average (GPA) of 2.25 at the time they submit an application.
- 2. Be 18 years of age by the time they depart for Florence.

Students who have <u>not</u> met the minimum units/GPA qualifications may use their current college semester transcript in progress to meet the criteria, but may be unable to enroll in the program until after midterm grades have been posted and they can demonstrate they meet the requirements as listed above. After midterm reports have been verified, these students may be admitted to the program as "provisional" students.

It will be the provisional student's responsibility to complete the Fall 2020 semester with 12 transferable college units and a GPA of 2.25.

Provisional students <u>will be dropped</u> from the program if, after final grades for the Fall 2020 semester are issued, usually in early January 2021, it is evident that they have not met the minimum criteria.

IMPORTANT: Students who are dropped from the program due to not meeting the minimum requirements <u>may forfeit all fees paid.</u>

This is a risk that any "provisional student" needs to consider seriously before filling out an application for the Spring 2021 Study Abroad Program.

Provisional Student Agreement

I have been advised of the above requirements for SRJC's Study Abroad Program and understand that if I fail to complete 12 transferable college units with at least a 2.25 GPA at the end of Fall Semester 2020, I will be dropped from the program and may forfeit all fees paid. I acknowledge this risk and will share this information with family, friends, or financial institutions that may be loaning me money for this program.
