 Students who are on academic probation or dismissal, or who have below a 2.00 GPA, will not be accepted into this program. If you're not sure, you can look up your unofficial transcript in your SRJC portal ("View Grades") or email the Study Abroad coordinator at pwarne@santarosa.edu.
- From the above link, you'll be instructed to create an AIFS account and then can fill out the application. Just follow the steps.
- Complete the enrollment form and make your deposit on the AIFS website. You will need to make the \$450 deposit before your application is considered complete.
- Once you have completed the AIFS enrollment form and have made your deposit to AIFS, you
 will be contacted via email by Patty Warne of the Study Abroad Office, who'll ask you for some
 forms and provide you with more details.

Financial Aid: Financial aid in the summer is more limited than in fall and spring, but the Promise Grant and the Pell Grant are still available for qualifying students.
