1. First, ENROLL WITH AIFS by clicking on the following link:

<https://secure.aifsabroad.com/Partnership/application/welcome.aspx?cpi=QGNYHA1BWDN7>

- a. From the above link, go to where it says "Click here to complete your enrollment form." (Make sure you use the same name as your passport and answer the questions honestly.)
- b. Complete the enrollment form and make your deposit on the AIFS website. You will need to make the \$450 deposit before your application is considered complete).
- c. Once you have completed the AIFS Enrollment Form *and* have made your deposit on the AIFS website, you will be contacted via email by Patty Warne of the Study Abroad Office. (Currently, we are still working remotely, so instead of an office visit, we will be working mostly by email and you'll be asked to submit any needed forms by email.)

- ☐ Fill out and submit the 2022/2023 FASFA (if you haven't already).
- ☐ **VERY IMPORTANT STEP:** If you expect to receive the California Promise Grant, add the following Title IV Codes to your FASFA: You probably already have SRJC's code of 001287. Please also add the codes for Los Medanos College (010340), Cañada College (006973), and American River College (001232). This allows you to receive the CA Promise Grant if you take any classes through these schools.
- ☐ If you expect to receive financial aid, make an appointment with Lauren Coburn of Financial Aid by emailing her at lcoburn@santarosa.edu. There are important forms you'll need to fill out. Lauren will need to know the classes you intend to take, so it's usually best to make the appointment after you've filled out your Course Preference Sheet (which you will receive after you've placed your deposit). **NOTE: You cannot receive financial aid while studying abroad unless you make this appointment and follow through with the necessary forms.**
