There will be at least 4 scholarships available only to SRJC students who have been accepted into this program. These scholarships range from about \$450 to \$2,000. Here's what you need to know:

Eligibility for Internship Scholarships:

- Must be accepted into the Virtual International Internship program for Spring 2021. *(By the way, if you aren't sure if you'll be in the program, you can still submit your scholarship application and narrative. However, if you wind up not participating, we will withdraw your application.)*
- Must be a current SRJC student enrolled in at least 6 units.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50.
- If you are named a scholarship recipient, you'll receive your scholarship via the Scholarship Office probably in early spring 2021. **YOU MUST CARRY A MINIMUM OF 12 UNITS DURING SPRING 2021 TO RECEIVE THE SCHOLARSHIP.** (If you are only taking 9 units through SRJC plus 3 units for the required SMCCCD COOP 671 class, you may be required to show the Scholarship Office proof of enrollment in the COOP class.)
- The scholarships for \$2,000 may require that you agree to submit an essay of your experience at the end of the program (the Scholarship Office will let you know).

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Write a narrative describing why you want to participate in an international internship. Some optional suggestions to consider in your paper: How will an international internship help you achieve both your academic and personal goals? Where do you want to intern, and why? What do you expect to get out of the experience?

Suggested length of the narrative is at least a page. You can borrow from the cover letter you wrote when applying to this program. Please type your narrative.

2. Provide a copy of your unofficial transcripts (go to “View Grades” in your student portal)

3. Fill out the internship scholarship application form (see below).

4. Email the 3 items (application form, unofficial transcripts, and your narrative) **on or by Nov. 13, 2020, to Patty Warne of the Study Abroad office:**
