



***The AIFS program fee of \$4,765.00 includes the following (based on an enrollment 20-24 participants):***

- Assistance of AIFS Student Services staff to accompany the group in Dublin, Galway and Belfast, and provide 24-hour emergency contact service
- Private bus transfers between each program city, per the program itinerary
- Guided sightseeing walking tours in Dublin, Galway, and Belfast, with a group meal in each city
- Medical and program fee refund insurance policies

**Dublin**

- Orientation program in Dublin consisting of a meeting with AIFS staff, and information on safety and security
- Student housing in single rooms within a shared apartment/dorm at Trinity College Dublin including kitchen/laundry access, and WiFi
- Leap Card travel pass for use on the buses, Luas and Dart trains in Dublin (and select public buses in Galway) pre-loaded with €25
- Library access on Trinity College campus
- Student logins for access to computer labs on Trinity College campus, if requested
- Campus tour of Trinity College, including entrance to the Book of Kells exhibit and the Old Library
- Ticket to a Bloomsday Event
- Visit to the Yeats Exhibit at the National Library of Ireland, the Gallery of Photography, and the Museum of Literature

The excursion also includes scones, tea or coffee, homemade soda bread with vegetable soup and a visit to Trim Castle

**Galway**

- Student housing in single rooms within a shared apartment/dorm at the National University of Ireland, Galway, including kitchen/laundry access, and WiFi
- Visit to the Cliffs of Moher
- Full-day guided excursion to the Aran Islands by ferry

**Belfast**

- Student housing in single rooms within a shared apartment/dorm at Queen’s Elms Village at Queen’s University Belfast, including kitchen/laundry access, and WiFi
- Translink travel pass for use on the public transit system in Belfast
- Visit to the Belfast Compact Photo Festival
- Black Cab tour of the Belfast Murals and Peace Wall
- Full-day Derry by private bus including a visit to the Seamus Heaney Home Place in Bellaghy, the Museum of Free Derry and the Londonderry murals
- Full-day excursion from Belfast to the Antrim Coast by private bus including entrance to the Giant’s Causeway and Carrick-a-rede Rope Bridge, stops at some Game of Thrones filming locations, and a group lunch

***Program fee does not include the following:***

- Optional Transportation Package consisting of round-trip airfare between San Francisco and Dublin, and round-trip transfers overseas between the airport and student housing on the specified program dates for \$895
- Mandatory additional U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$390 (subject to change)

All students must submit the \$450 deposit when completing the online enrollment form. Subsequent payments may be made by check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to "AIFS." American Express, MasterCard and Visa are also accepted.

Please note: AIFS will charge a \$35 returned check fee on all checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

## AIFS TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE

Participants have the option of purchasing a round-trip ticket for the flight arranged through AIFS. Participants choosing this option should note the following restrictions: Tickets purchased from AIFS are exclusively on scheduled airlines (not charters). They are not endorsable to another carrier. Flights are not necessarily direct or non-stop, they cannot be rerouted, and frequent flyer miles are not applicable. The AIFS Transportation Package includes round-trip ground transportation from the airports in Ireland to your accommodations on the regularly scheduled program dates. AIFS will book flights only on the dates indicated on this application. AIFS will not make your flight arrangements for you unless you clearly indicate your travel preferences on your online enrollment form. A minimum of 10 participants must take the flight for it to be offered.

Participants wishing to purchase the Transportation Package should select this option on the online enrollment form, or if you wish to add the flight after you complete the form you must notify AIFS in writing by Friday, March 20, 2020, or by notifying AIFS in writing. Participants wishing to cancel from the flight must notify AIFS in writing by Tuesday, April 21, 2020. Cancellation penalties will apply. Tickets are non-refundable after this date.

**AIFS Airfare Regulations:** Return must be to original U.S. departure city. Tickets are subject to airline availability. No refunds are available for any unused portion of ticket. Stopovers are not permitted. Once in Ireland, participants may be able to change their return date, but only if that date is available and in the same class of service in which the ticket was booked. Only the ticketing agent can provide this information. Participants are subject to agency and airline-imposed change fees and space availability. Group round-trip ground transportation to and from the airports in Ireland is on the regularly scheduled program dates only. AIFS cannot guarantee that all passengers will be booked on the same flight.
