NCASC London Program Fall Semester 2020



The AIFS program fee of \$8,595.00 is based on an enrollment of 80 students and includes the following:

Option A: Shared Apartment: \$9,995.00 Option B: Shared Homestay: \$8,595.00

- Option A Accommodations in a supervised AIFS residence including a shared kitchen, private bathroom, and Wifi
- Option B Accommodations in a twin room in a homestay within a residential neighborhood of London including kitchen privileges, linens, daily breakfast, and Wifi

Both Options Include:

- Orientation program including an orientation meeting with AIFS staff, information on safety/security and travel, and a half-day guided sightseeing tour of London by private bus
- London Transport travel pass giving unlimited use of the buses and underground trains. Homestay students receive a multizone (usually zones 1-3) travel card, and apartment students receive a central zone (zones 1 & 2) travel card
- British Life and Culture lecture series focusing on historical, political, economic and cultural aspects of contemporary Britain, including weekly lectures and four local field trips
- Membership of the Imperial College Union, giving access to over 370 Union clubs and societies, and to Imperial College
 events
- Membership with borrowing rights of the local public libraries
- Weekly cultural program of heavily subsidized extra-curricular activities including day trips, theater performances and sporting events
- International Student Identity Card (ISIC)
- Access to the AIFS Student Center and a team of dedicated AIFS Student Services staff for information, personal advising/counseling, and 24-hour emergency contact service
- Medical and program fee refund insurance policies

Program fees do not include the following:

- Optional transportation package including round-trip airfare between Los Angeles (LAX) and Heathrow (LHR) and round-trip transfers overseas between the airport and the student housing on the standard program dates for \$TBC
- Mandatory U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$TBC (subject to change)
- Optional four-day/three-night guided weekend trip to Scotland including round-trip train ticket, 3 nights' hostel accommodation and daily breakfast for \$625
- NCSAC tuition or administrative fees
- Textbooks
- Meals other than those listed above
- Passport and visa fees if applicable
- Field trips or excursions other than those specified
- Personal expenses such as laundry
- Optional personal effects coverage and medical insurance upgrade

All students must submit the \$450 deposit when completing the online enrollment form. Subsequent payments may be made by check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to "AIFS." American Express, MasterCard and Visa are accepted.

Please note: AIFS will charge a \$35 returned check fee on all checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

AIFS TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE

Participants have the option of purchasing a round-trip ticket for the flight arranged through AIFS. Participants choosing this option should note the following restrictions: Tickets purchased from AIFS are exclusively on scheduled airlines (not charters). They are not endorsable to another carrier. Flights are not necessarily direct or non-stop, they cannot be rerouted, and frequent flyer miles are not applicable. The AIFS Transportation Package includes round-trip ground transportation from the airport overseas to your accommodations on the regularly scheduled program dates. AIFS will book flights only on the dates indicated on this application.

Participants wishing to purchase the Transportation Package should select this option on the online enrollment form, or if you wish to add the flight after you complete the form you must notify AIFS in writing by Wednesday, June 17, 2020. Participants wishing to cancel from the flight must notify AIFS in writing by Friday, July 17, 2020. Cancellation penalties will apply. Tickets are non-refundable after this date.

AIFS Airfare Regulations: Return must be to original U.S. departure city. Tickets are subject to airline availability. No refunds are available for any unused portion of ticket. Stopovers are not permitted. Once overseas, participants may be able to change their return date, but only if that date is available and in the same class of service in which the ticket was booked. Only the ticketing agent can provide this information. Participants are subject to agency and airline-imposed change fees and space availability.

AIFS cannot guarantee that all passengers will be booked on the same flight.

AIFS will <u>not</u> make your flight arrangements for you unless you clearly indicate your travel preferences on your online enrollment form.

A minimum of 10 participants must take the flight for it to be offered.
